Colorado Symphony Ratifies 1-Year Agreement

On December 11, 2005, the musicians of the Colorado Symphony ratified a one-year agreement that is retroactive from July 1, 2005 and continues through June 30, 2006.

LENGTH OF SEASON: 43 weeks

WAGES:	[2004-05]	2005-06
Annual Salary –	[\$38,251.94]	\$39,272.76
Weekly Salary –	[\$889.58]	\$913.32

EMG: Remains at \$60 per week/\$2,580 annually.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Premiums for doubling, move-up pay and performing other parts will be paid at the new rate commencing December 26, 2006.
- Parking allotment of \$15 per month increases to \$20 per month.
- Musicians will not be penalized for any schedule changes announced within 4 weeks of any service (was 2 weeks).
