The members of the Syracuse Symphony ratified a new three-year agreement on May 7, 1999.

**LENGTH OF SEASON:** Remains 38 weeks

**WAGES:**

1998-99	<b>\$636.19</b> /\$24,175.22
1999/2000	<b>\$648.91</b> /\$24,658.58
2000/01	<b>\$674.87</b> /\$25,645.06

**VACATION:** Remains 4 weeks

**AUDITIONS:** Music director has **two** votes in final (was three). Regular per diem amounts will be applied to audition committee service: lunch per diem will be paid when morning audition extends beyond 1:00 p.m.; dinner per diem will be paid when afternoon audition extends beyond 6:00 p.m.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** Music director is prohibited from dismissal action against a musician in the final year of the music director's contract.
