The Buddy System



- Moving to a new city
- Starting a new (or first) job
- Around a new group of people and new culture
- Every tenure process is different

- Essentially a 'mentor'
- A good mentor should <u>not</u> be:
 - The Music Director or resident conductor, or any member of Mgmt
 - The section Principal (or anyone titled higher)
 - Anyone part of the musician's tenure review

 A mentor <u>could</u> be another musician in the section

- A good mentor <u>must</u> be someone who:
 - Has been in the orchestra for a while
 - Has the respect of the Musicians
 - Knows the contract
 - Will put in the time

What does a good mentor do?

- Regular conversations outside of work
 - Tenure process
 - Orchestra culture
 - Workplace relationships
 - Life outside of work

New Musician Events

Indoctrination: Part 2

- Crucial to ingrain a sense of belonging
- Introduction to the culture of the orchestra
- Introduction to the people who are the Orchestra, Local, OC, and ICSOM


Invitees should include:



Team Building

An Orchestra that 'plays' together, 'stays' together



- Orchestra meetings are not quality 'bonding' time
- Team building needs to happen separately from the 'work' of the Orchestra

Community Outreach

- Volunteering at a local food bank, animal shelter, or charity
- Organizing a community service event, like a race, fundraiser, or toy drive

Community Performances

- In conjunction with *or* separate from community service
- Different locations away from your hall
- Different instrumentations working with people in new ways

Meals

- BBQ or potluck at a local home or park
- Reception for the *musicians* after a performance
- Lunch between services without conducting business

'Non-Meetings'

- Invite a retired member of the orchestra to address the group
- Inviting a soloist to do the same
- Yoga
- Book club
- Quilting!

- All musicians need to be invited, encouraged, and welcome to participate in these events
- Make sure everyone is included
- May require a coordinator or committee to handle planning
