## **What you need (same as last time):**

1. Headphones
2. A device to play the reference recording

4. A device to record yourself playing the part (this can be a computer, phone, tablet)

## **What you will do:**

1. Set up your recording equipment
2. Put on your headphones so that you are sure that you won't record the reference recording that you are listening to
3. Start recording yourself
4. Start the reference recording and play along with it
5. When you are done, send an email to [isomusicianssocial@gmail.com](mailto:isomusicianssocial@gmail.com), and we'll send you instructions about how to upload your video.

  - If you have a Mac, you can use Photobooth, and there is probably a Windows equivalent

- Make sure we can see you well. For best results, try to have the light coming at you from behind the camera.
- Don't worry about specific dress, just come as you are
- If you'd rather just send audio, that's fine also!
